  - Should possess moral integrity (no criminal record)
  - Must provide letter of recommendation from a local teacher, business owner or notable community member by entry deadline date
  - Consistent school attendance (certified attendance record from attendance office to accompany application; home schooled students to provide copy of school registration form)
  - Must agree to relinquish any titles held within the same age division competing for, if crowned Teen or Miss Barstow
- If it is proven, any contestant or their family who exhibits unsportsmanlike conduct, will be ineligible for future competitions at the directors discretion.
- Previous contestants may compete provided they have not held the title they are competing for at any time in the past.
- Past or current princesses may compete provided they upheld their contract for a majority of time throughout their years reign in the division they wish to compete in.
- Contestant is judged on the basis of physical fitness, poise, personality, stage and microphone presence and a personal interview.
- A \$100.00 application fee (non-refundable/non-transferable) must accompany this completed application in order to hold you a soot. Due to COVID total applements fee is \$300
- Contestants (parent/quardian/other family member if contestant is under 18) are required to attend an orientation to be held on entry deadline day.
- Contestant is required to attend a minimum of 10 of the scheduled rehearsals. Dress rehearsal is mandatory.

#### RULES

- 4. An early registration day will be held where a discount is offered if entries are in and paid by this date, tickets will be distributed.
  - \* Even if applications are mailed in, contestant and a parent must attend one of the registration sessions. All questions will be answered and this is where a digital photo of your child will be taken for the program book. If you don't have your photo taken at this time, your photo will not be in the program book.
- 5. Entry fee, cover & centerfold model & portfolio fees must be paid by entry deadline date. (All photos due at this time)
- 6. Mini-Optionals and Photogenic may be entered up to REHEARSAL NIGHT. CASH ONLY

- 12. Parents & contestants/titleholders with unhealthy attitudes regarding the pageant & activities throughout the year, will be un-invited to events & may be ineligible for future pageants.
- 13. The "First in Picks Line-up" Rule applies. This means that the sooner you get your application in with a minimum deposit of \$25, you will have the opportunity to pick your place in the line-up.
